The Wessex Committee and its appointment group moderators reserves the right to delete posts on the club's social media sites/pages that contain:

- 1. Vulgar language/images.
- 2. Personal attacks.
- 3. Comments or content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination or negative opinions on the basis of race, creed, colour, age, religion, gender, marital status, genetics, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or intellectual disability or sexual orientation.
- 4. Spam or links to off-topic sites.
- 5. Clearly off topic comments, including but not limited to arguments over politics or politicians, discussions on religious beliefs and their credibility, or explicitly sexual posts.
- 6. Advocating or advertising illegal activity and/or misuse of cave and karst resources.
- 7. Promotion of particular services, products, or political organizations.
- 8. Infringement on copyrights or trademarks.
- 9. Another person's private personal data.
- 10. Private land or cave locations, including GPS coordinates, latitude and longitude, specific directions, or indications on maps or photos without express permission of the landowner.
- 11. Repeated or similar posts.

Posts express the views of the author, and are not necessarily those of the club, committee or its general membership. By posting any material, you confirm, represent, and warrant that you have the lawful right to distribute and reproduce such material.
